A Letter From Our Founder and Executive Director

Hello!

Can I ask you a couple questions?
Who does trauma look like?
Who does domestic violence look like?
Finally, who does normal look like?

My name is Tisha Dolby and I have been working in the healing & self-love arenas for over 25 years. Power Passion Purpose Inc is a faith-based organization, and I am the founder and executive director, dedicated to ending the generational cycle of trauma, violence, and abuse.

Our primary focus is women. Our organization was birthed from my personal experience and a vision God gave me. The increasing need to end trauma, violence and abuse filling the gap in the services provided to women. We focus on the Healing component and the tools necessary to finally break the cycle.

We work with our clients to develop individualized personal action plans. Every woman goes through our New Empowered Woman Program first. As trauma, violence, and abuse is multi-layered and multi-generational so is our approach. We provide tangible resources and support to the woman for her mental, emotional, physical, and spiritual wellbeing that can change the trajectory of her life.

Image you are 14 years old, the youngest of 3 girls, your oldest sister has a baby, your middle sister is pregnant, your mother is an alcoholic, your father is absent, out of the home, remarried and living in another state and you find yourself pregnant...

This was my welcome to the world. I am the 3rd generation in one household to be affected by trauma, violence, and abuse. Unfortunately, it progressively got worse as I later became a victim of child abuse, sexual assault, and a ward of the state.

And if you can imagine YES...the system failed me as well...

As a result, it left me lost, broken, confused and unequipped to manage adulting....finding myself in an adult domestic violence relationship and newly pregnant with my 2nd child....My first child passed away from SIDS...the loss of my daughter became the catalyst of my healing and self-love journey and the birth of the heartbeat of our organization. Power Passion Purpose Inc exists to stop the generational cycle of Trauma, violence, and abuse.

You may be asking yourself what sets us apart from other organizations, first we are led by a survivor/ overcomer who has healed and stopped that very cycle within the raising of her own children...secondly, we lead from a place of meeting the woman where she is and staying with her throughout her journey.... And lastly, by providing the necessary support that the woman needs to make the needed changes to save her life and the lives of her children.

I am asking you to partner with me and power Passion Purpose Inc as we continue to impact the women in our community. There are many opportunities to do this from monetary donations, product donations, and sponsorships for events and activities.

- Per Texas Domestic Violence Statistics of 2020 Harris County accounted for 41,300 almost doubling the next county of Dallas with 22,136. 25.8% of the total number of reported Family Violence Incidents in Texas.
- The numbers from the Texas Council of Family Violence are staggering:
- Harris County saw a 40% increase in domestic violence homicides, from 2019-2020
 - In Texas, there was a 23% increase over the same period.
- Family violence homicides in Texas grew by nearly 80%, and more than half involved a gun.
- Houston Police said strangulation calls increased 130% in the first year of the pandemic.
 - Data shows that Northwest Houston has an estimated population of 303,409 women.
 - The service population has limited access to resources, supportive services, a way out.
 - Nearest Domestic Violence shelter is over 20 miles away from servicing area.

As you can see the need is great and the crisis is growing. We cannot continue the work without our wonderful community partners, donors, and sponsors. While we are making strides within the community, we serve we know there is more to be done and we are planning to open a phased out transitional housing program and resource center allowing us to serve the women from call to self-sufficiency. I ask again who does trauma look like, who does domestic violence look like, and who does normal look like? And the answer is ME! Tisha.... I am healed, healthy, and whole helping other women break the cycle...


